## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## Will there be an art show in the end?

No. This camp is more process-focused than product-focused. Students will do many drawings and several sculptures, but the aim is to build hard skills, not create finished artworks.

## Will there be nudes?

This is an art camp and we will be looking at images of some of the greatest masterpieces in art history. Some of the art will depict nudes. We will have a discussion about why artists draw, paint, and sculpt nudes; and why it is different than nudity in other contexts. We will also draw and sculpt from live models, but the models will wear leotards or swimwear. The models I hire are professionals that I have worked with in the past. Please reach out to me if you have any questions or concerns.

## What are you doing to keep everyone safe?

I carry liability insurance and have had a criminal background check to work with children through my church. The first day we will discuss safety and come up with our own group rules and expectations.

What about COVID 19? I am fully vaccinated, though it will not be required for campers. The studio is well-ventilated and on nice days we will have the garage bay open. If the situation changes, we will follow CDC guidelines.
